Dear Sir,

I was pleased to hear your station 'Radio Rhino International' on Tuesday the 16th of September 2003, from 15:00 to 15:23 hours U.T.C., on the shortwave frequency of 17555 kHz.

Reception was generally very good. The strong signal was mostly audible and readable. There was light interference from China National Radio on 17560 kHz. Static noise was light and rare, and fades were deep and brief, causing few readability difficulties. Overall, the signal was received with little difficulty here in Australia.

Below are details of your English language program I heard:

U.T.C.

15:00 Music and ID announcements 'You are listening to Radio Rhino International, Africa', and 'This is your voice of freedom and democracy.', 'Hello, you are on the right wave.',

15:02 Song 'If I Had A Hammer', by a male singer, ID's over the song,

15:05 Male host mentioned countries where your station has been heard, including Australia, also gave phone number +0049 0162 8854486 for SMS messages, and Internet website address,

15:06 Talk about programming, how 'the views of the common man must be voiced',

15:11 ID & item about the police force in Uganda and the power of information (press and radio),

15:16 ID & announcements about plans for the station, requesting the return of rights for Ugandans,

15:21 ID, music then announcements about how the 'silence must be brought to an end',

15:23 End of the monitoring period.

My radio is a Drake R8 communications receiver with a 20 metre longwire antenna.

Could you please check the details of this report with your station log ?
If you find them to be correct, could you please send me your card or letter
of verification, letting me know if it was your station that I heard ? I
would be pleased to receive this from you.

I hope that you find this report to be useful. I am a 35 year-old student
and have been a radio hobbyist since 1985. May your station have continued
success with its broadcasts in the future.
