'I know nothing of Radio Rhino'- **September 8, 2003**

KAMPALA - Dr Kizza Besigye, a losing candidate in the 2001 presidential election, has denied that he is scheduled to speak at the launch of a radio station by Ugandan exiles in Germany.

On Friday The Monitor reported that Besigye, together with former President Milton Obote, would speak at the launch of Radio Rhino International-Africa on September 16.

The RRIA Director, Mr Godfrey Ayoo, had claimed that Besigye and Obote would be aired on September 16 and 17.

"I have never heard of or been in touch with anyone by the names of Godfrey Elum Ayoo or any other person acting on behalf of Radio Rhino International-Africa (RRIA)," Besigye said by e-mail yesterday.

"I have no knowledge of any launch of such a radio or my joint participation with former President Milton Obote in any radio programme," he wrote
