

Uganda's Reform Agenda welcomes new radio station

Ugandan political pressure group the Reform Agenda (RA) says it welcomes the establishment of **Radio Rhino International-Africa** (RRIA), the German-based station now due to launch on 23 September, a week later than originally planned. RA deputy secretary general Louis Otika told journalists at the weekly press conference that although RA leader Dr Kizza Besigye has not yet been contacted by the station's owners, the organisation welcomes any moves that would give the opposition more voice. "We have not yet bought broadcasting equipment of our own and we do not have any immediate plans to buy such equipment. So if there is an opportunity for us to contribute positively to Uganda's political development using that station we shall take advantage of it," Otika said.
